Lucía, a Galician journalist in Lisbon, returns to her hometown of Seara to report on a devastating forest fire. But for her, it's personal.

Her father, Afonso, the 'Abaneiro', was accused of arson 30 years ago, and the fire killed a child. Lucía believes he was innocent and took his life in prison for a crime he didn't commit. Returning to Seara means confronting painful memories and a village that still sees her as the daughter of a criminal.

Met with hostility, she finds an ally in Júlio, a discreet Portuguese National Republican Guard corporal. As their attraction grows, he helps her investigate. With Agent Salgueiro, she reveals a cover-up: the fire's cause is being concealed, and its pattern matches the one pinned on her father.

Determined to expose the truth, Lucía follows a trail that leads to a shell company acquiring burned land for a wind farm – as was the case 30 years ago. With help from Ana, a Galician intern at a small newspaper, and Xan, a teenage hacker, she begins to unravel a web of corruption. The scheme involves politicians and businessmen who have shaped the region's fate for decades, including high-ranking Portuguese official Armando Sá Silva and Seara's mayor, Iolanda.

Meanwhile, the police investigate the suspicious death of Martim, a botanist whose research may hold the key to the mystery. As Lucía gets closer to the truth, she realises that the same powerful forces that framed her father are still at work – and they will do whatever it takes to keep their secrets buried.

David works at the Institute of Paranormal Phenomena and is a sceptic. His job is to investigate paranormal phenomena, but he doesn't believe in such nonsense. If a UFO abducts a respectable fellow citizen, a puppet kills a ventriloquist, a goat monster attacks a tramp settlement or a saint spontaneously self-ignites, David is convinced that there is nothing behind it all but ordinary human deception.

It's the 80s and there are a lot of annoying people out there calling each

other 'comrade'. David prefers to sit in the comfort of his office, pretending to be researching satanic references in western music and enjoying listening to LPs that no one else in the country has.

The world would be beautiful, but the director of the Institute of Paranormal Phenomena, his superior, puts a new colleague Vojta in his office. And this overly motivated newcomer has a lot to say: how it's necessary to push the boundaries of human knowledge and that science apparently doesn't yet have the answers to all the mysteries of the world.

This mismatched pair have no choice but to work together to investigate bizarre cases that all the other security forces in the state fall short on. And to make sure that their lives aren't unnecessarily easy, two secret police agents are constantly breathing down their neck – tough agent Snížková and sweetheart Hora.

A dramatic, gripping family saga, concurrent storylines run past and present as White Night Season two takes us back to the 80s. No longer satisfied with her modelling career, Louise Hébert-Lacombe's (Rose-Marie Perreault) dreams of setting up a cosmetics company with her friend and former neighbour Jacinthe. Thanks in part to mentor Aidrian, Nocturne was born, developing into a powerhouse cosmetic industry empire. In her relentless pursuit of opulence, fame, and power, Louise must face major adverse events, maturing into present-day Loulou (France Castel). Meanwhile, Aidrian, obsessed with protecting and further propelling Loulou's success, lets himself be dominated more and more by his dark side. Murdered on the eve of the launch of her new fragrance, the Hébert clan embarks on a pursuit to find LouLou's killer. Though seemingly solved, it appears that Clémence killed Loulou. What Aidrian and the Hébert children don't

know, but soon realise, is that Clémence did not act alone but had an accomplice. Familial bonds fray in their pursuit of this other culprit, with the Hébert clan beginning to tear each other apart. Revelations highlight cracks in each of the characters, generating suspicion, betrayal and shameful secrets that severely test family loyalty and lay a web of self-destruction. Thrown into situations that force them to cross boundaries, their decisions could have serious consequences that may forever undermine the ties that bind them. Will the clan survive the ordeal?

The hit series Ku'damm is back for its highly anticipated fourth season, stepping into a new era: the groovy, rebellious Seventies.

Rejected by the King of Portugal to finance an expedition to mythical lands in pursuit of priceless spices, explorer Ferdinand Magellan convinces the Spanish Crown to fund the mission that will take an unexplored ocean route west.

Setting sail 500 years ago with 5 Spanish ships and a crew of 265 men, including commander and former prisoner Juan Sebastián Elcano, Magellan's journey would face sabotage by the Portuguese, as well as hostile Spanish foes. With unimaginable suffering – starvation, death and punishing weather – sailors resorted to mutiny after a year at sea until finally finding the Strait of Magellan. A critical juncture after reaching the Philippines would test leadership, requiring captain and crew to battle the indigenous tribes, resulting in disastrous losses before continuing their journey.

Former anti-hero, Elcano, not Magellan, would lead the expedition to glory, returning 3 years later with 18

survivors and a hull full of spices, as captain of one of the greatest navigational triumphs. This legacy of travelling to the Earth's unknown ends would change man's perception of the world and the existence of an ocean route west.





Estonia, 1820s. The Baltic German nobility has largely retained its autonomy within the Russian Empire. Some of the estates are wealthier than small German principalities. Many struggle – luxuries and lavish lifestyles, drinking and gambling put a strain on the family budgets. Younger brothers are often left empty-handed, joining the Russian army or learning a trade to earn an income. And among the ethnic Estonians, national awakening is stirring.

Paul von Fock, the youngest of three brothers, has recently inherited the prosperous Sagadi manor – much to the surprise of his social circle, of which he is not the most popular member, and the middle son Ferdinand, whose vanity could use a higher income.

When Paul is elected the assessor of the local court by the Knighthood, he doesn't expect to solve anything beyond pub brawls and petty disputes between neighbours. But when the murder of his childhood bully, notorious swindler Justus von Brevern, becomes his first case, the extent of his responsibility suddenly dawns on him. Paul enlists the help of Gerhard Wagner, his university friend and governor, who starts off as a rather unwilling, but eventually useful sidekick, and must resign himself to the help of Maria von Nottbeck, his childhood friend and notorious femme fatale, who will accept any entertainment she can find in this periphery of Europe after returning from her adventures abroad.

These two are clearly meant for each other, but whatever mess Maria has got herself into during her travels is still haunting her, and figuring her out proves the toughest case Paul will face.
